Where do we Draw the Line?

Eligibility:

Open to all artists in the Capital Region of Upstate New York, 2D and 3D media. Work entered for our Where do we draw the Line Exhibit should meet the following requirements:
(1) Artwork must reflect civil liberties or political activism
(2) No larger than 5'
(3) Must have been completed since January 2006 and not previously shown at a UAG event.

Specifications:

Entrants are limited only by imagination, ability and the following:

Maximum size is 5' in any direction. 2D work must be suitably framed and firmly wired for hanging. No sawtooth hangers or "sandwich" frames. Painting, drawing, photography and sculpture are accepted.
Work must be able to be hand delivered and picked up on the dates specified.

Entry Procedure and Fees:

Artists are required to present prints, digital images on CD or via email, or actual work (prior notification required) with this submission form. For installation work, a detailed description and sketch will suffice. Submissions must be received by the submission deadline in order to be considered.

The entry fee is \$25, or \$10 for members in good standing. Details on membership and discount requirements may be found online here: <http://upstateartistsguild.org/info/membership.php>

Submissions must be clearly labeled with the following:

- Artist's name
- Title of work
- Size of work (WxH, xD if applicable)
- Price of work

Entry Checklist:

1. Completed and signed entry form
2. Digital files or prints as indicated
3. Cash, check, or money order made out to UAG
4. Artist's bio

Delivery and Return of Accepted Work:

Accepted work must be hand-delivered and picked up during stated hours unless prior arrangements have been made.
The UAG cannot store work.

Sales:

Artists receive commission based on their level and status of membership.

All work must be for sale. No pricing changes will be permitted after acceptance of work.
