Entry procedure: Please present the actual work with this submission form.

Submissions must be received on **Saturday 4/19 or Sunday, 4/20 between 2 and 6pm at the UAG Gallery**. Each artist may submit **one** piece. There is no fee to donate your work. Artists who donate work will receive a complimentary ticket to the event!

Work must be clearly labeled with:

- Artist's name
- Title of work
- Medium
- Value

If you cannot drop off your work on the specified dates, please email Rebecca.schoonmaker@uagmembers.org to set up a time to deliver your work.

Sales: This event is a Silent Auction. People attending the event will bid on your work by writing down how much they'd like to pay on a sheet of paper next to your artwork. We will include the actual value of the work (as noted by the artist) and we will calculate a reasonable starting bid. No pricing changes will be allowed after acceptance.

Artists will receive 60% of the winning price. The 40% sales handling fee will go directly towards the operating expenses of the UAG Gallery. Artists may also choose to donate the entire sale of the work to the UAG. We cannot thank you enough for participating in this show.

Works not sold at the Auction can be picked up at the UAG Gallery on Sat. 4/26 or Sun. 4/27 between 2-6pm or by special arrangement.
