Eligibility: Open to all Folk artists. All media is permitted. Work must have been completed in the last 24 months and not previously shown at a UAG event. Work must be hand-delivered or shipped and picked up or include return shipping on the dates specified. **THE UAG CANNOT STORE WORK!!!!**

Specifications: Entrants are limited only by imagination, ability and the following:

- Maximum size of work in any direction is 4 feet.
- Work must be framed, wired, and ready to be hung*.
- Work must be clearly labeled with the artist's name, name of work, price, and contact information.
- Artists are encouraged to submit a 1-2 page bio (typed and printed or emailed to submissions@upstateartistsguild.org) with their entry.

Entry procedure and fees: Artists are encouraged to use our online submission form at www.upstateartistsguild.org/exhibit/upload.php. If you can not submit online, please present prints, digital images on cd or via email with this submission form. If you would like your submission materials returned to you, please include a self addressed stamped envelope for those materials.

Submissions must be **postmarked by March 11th, 2007** or received by midnight on **March 14th, 2007**. Each artist may submit up to 5 pieces. Submission fee for this show is \$10 for UAG members in good standing and \$25 for non-members. **Offline Submissions must be clearly labeled with:**

- Artist's name
- Title of work
- Medium
- Size (HxW, xD if applicable)

Shipping/Delivery Instructions:

Accepted work must be dropped off at the Gallery on March 29th or 30th from 2-6PM or received by mail by March 28th 2007. *Artwork that can not be hand delivered should be shipped to:

Sales: Although artists may opt for their work to be Not For Sale, we encourage you to price your work. No pricing changes will be allowed after acceptance. Artists whose work is sold through the UAG will be charged a Sales Handling Fee of 25%. (UAG 25% /Artist 75%).
