We invite you to show your work in our gallery as part of an unjuried show. All pieces submitted will be accepted into the show, but space is limited so we encourage entrants to pre-register online or with this form. During Art on Lark (6/20), the public will vote on their favorites and prizes will be awarded.

Eligibility: Open to all artists in Upstate New York. All media is permitted. Work must have been completed in the last 24 months and not previously shown at a UAG event. Work must be able to be hand-delivered and picked up on the dates specified.

Specifications: Entrants are limited only by imagination, ability and the following:

- Maximum size of work in any direction is 4 feet.
- Work must be framed, wired, and ready to be hung*.
- Work must be clearly labeled with the artist's name, name of work, price, and contact information.
- Artists are encouraged to submit a 1-2 page bio (typed and printed or emailed to submissions@upstateartistsguild.org) with their entry.

Entry procedure and fees: Artists are encouraged to pre-register by emailing images and entry form information to submissions@upstateartistsguild.org. If you can not pre-register by email, please mail or drop off this submission form.

Submissions received by May 29th will be considered pre-registered and will receive preference in the case that more submissions are received than the gallery can hold. Each artist may submit up to 2 pieces. Submission fee for this show is \$5. If you do not pre-register, you may bring your work, this form and the \$5 fee to the Gallery during drop off for the show.

Drop off dates are May 30th and May 31st from 2-6PM.

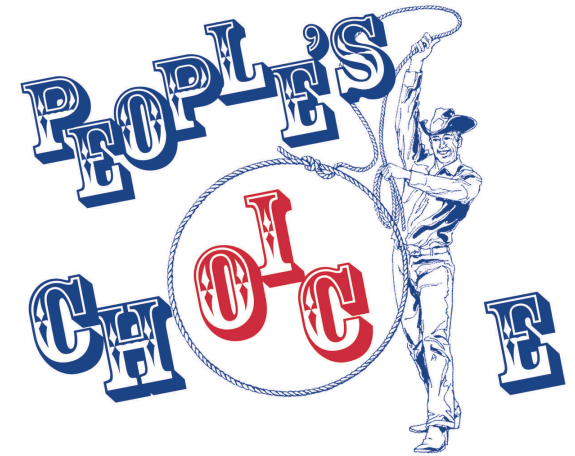
Entry checklist:

Sales: Although artists may opt for their work to be Not For Sale, we encourage you to price your work. The UAG Gallery is not-for-profit and depends on the sales handling fees, membership dues, and charitable donations to cover operating expenses. No pricing changes will be allowed after acceptance.

Artists whose work is sold through the UAG will be charged a Sales Handling Fee of 25%. (UAG 25% /Artist 75%).

Works not sold by June 26th must be picked up on June 27th/June 28th from 2-6PM or by special arrangement.

May 30th/May 31st 2p-6p

Work must be dropped off on the weekend of the 30th between the hours of 2-6pm. Please contact the Gallery Manager ahead of time if other arrangements are necessary. Artwork which is not dropped off during the times provided will not be included in the show.

June 5th - 26th

Exhibition dates. Opening reception will be First Friday, June 5, 6:00 - 9:00. Artists are encouraged to attend and donate food for the opening.

June 6th 11a-3p

Art on Lark is from 10a-5p. People attending Art on Lark will be invited to VOTE for their favorite pieces between 11a-3p with winners announced at 4p.

June 27th/28th 2p-6p
