**Eligibility:** Open to all video artists. All media is permitted. Work must have been completed in the last 24 months and not previously shown at a UAG event. Work must be able to be hand delivered and picked up on the dates specified.

**Specifications:** Entrants are limited only by imagination, ability, and the following:

- ◆ Maximum size of work in any direction is 4 feet.
- ◆ Work must be framed, wired, and ready to hang\*.
- ◆ Work must be clearly labeled with the artist's name, name of work, price, and contact information.

**Entry checklist:**

1. Completed and signed entry form
2. Cash or check/money order made payable to UAG or payment through PayPal
3. Digital or printed images. Do not send actual work.
4. Artists are encouraged to submit a 1-2 page bio (typed and printed or emailed to: [submissions@upstateartistsguild.org](mailto:submissions@upstateartistsguild.org)) with their entry.

**Entry procedure and fees:** Artists are encouraged to email images and submission form information to: [submissions@upstateartistsguild.org](mailto:submissions@upstateartistsguild.org). If you can not submit by email, please present prints or digital images on CD with this submission form.

Submissions must be **postmarked by August 10th 2010** or received by midnight on **August 13th 2010**. Each artist may submit up to 5 pieces. Submission fee for this show is \$10 for UAG members in good standing and \$25 for non-members. Offline Submissions must be clearly labeled with:

- Artist's name
- Title of work
- Medium
- Size (HxW, xD if applicable)

**Shipping/Delivery Instructions:**

Accepted work must be dropped off at the Gallery on August 28th or 29th from 2-6PM or received by mail by August 28th 2009. \*Art-work that can not be hand delivered should be shipped to:

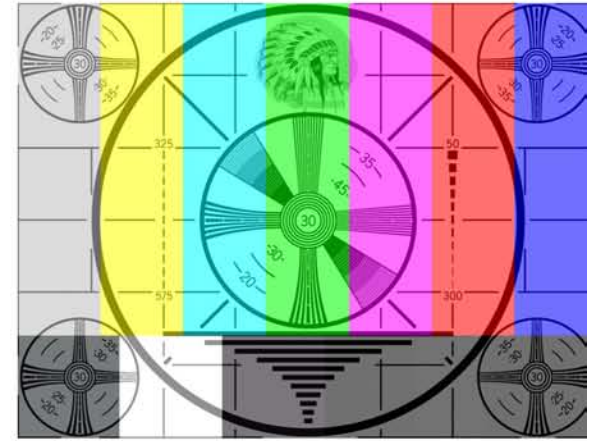

The Artist is responsible for shipping and return shipping costs. Please include a check or money order for return shipping made out to Upstate Artists Guild and include it in the box you ship your work in. UAG will not be responsible for loss or damage during shipping.

**Sales:** Although artists may opt for their work to be Not For Sale, we encourage you to price your work. The UAG Gallery is not-for-profit and depends on the sales handling fees, membership dues, and charitable donations to cover operating expenses. **No pricing changes will be allowed after acceptance.**

Artists whose work is sold through the UAG will be charged a Sales Handling Fee of 25% (UAG 25% / Artist 75%).

Works not sold by March 26th must be picked up on March 27th/28th from 2-6pm or by special arrangement.
