Eligibility: Open to all student artists in Upstate New York. All media is permitted. Work must have been completed in the last 12 months and not previously shown at a UAG event. Work must be able to be hand-delivered and picked up on the dates specified.

Specifications: Entrants are limited only by imagination, ability and the following:

- Maximum size of work in any direction is 4 feet.
- Work must be wired and ready to hang.
- Work must be clearly labeled with the artist's name, name of work, price, and contact information.

Entry checklist:

1. Completed and signed entry form
2. Cash or check/money order made out to UAG or payment through PayPal.
3. Digital or printed images. Do not send actual work.
4. Artists are encouraged to submit a 1-2 page bio (typed and printed or emailed to submissions@upstateartistsguild.org) with their entry.

Entry procedure and fees: Artists are encouraged to email images and submission form information to submissions@upstateartistsguild.org. If you can not submit by email, please present prints or digital images on CD with this submission form.

Submissions and Submission forms must be received by 6pm on **April 1st 2012**. The Submission fee for this show is \$5 per student (for 2 pieces) or \$30 per school (for up to 20 students or 40 pieces).

Non emailed submissions must be clearly labeled with:

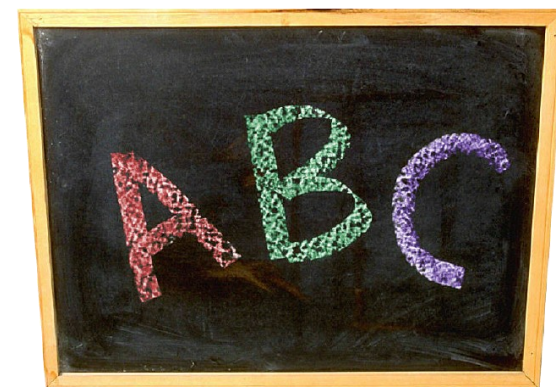
- Artist's name
- Title of work
- Medium
- Size (HxWxD if applicable)

Drop off dates for accepted work are Saturday, March 31st and Sunday, April 1st from 2-6PM. **Please contact the Gallery Manager ahead of time if other arrangements are necessary.**

Sales: Although artists may opt for their work to be Not For Sale, we encourage you to price your work. The UAG Gallery is not-for-profit and depends on the sales handling fees, membership dues, and charitable donations to cover operating expenses. **No pricing changes will be allowed after acceptance.**

Artists whose work is sold through the UAG will be charged a Sales Handling Fee of 25%. (UAG 25% /Artist 75%).

Works not sold by April 27th must be picked up on April 28/29th from 2-6PM or by special arrangement.
